Thursday, 17 May 2018:

19:30: Dinner in the restaurant of Schosshotel Hünigen

Saturday, 19 May 2018

09:30: Briefing; afterwards we will start our tour towards the Gürbetal. The Gürbetal is famous for producing white cabbage, which after harvesting, is turned into Sauerkraut.

10:00: Viewing of the Oldtimer Galerie in Toffen, a place well known for its Classic cars and bikes auctions. They have a permanent display of about 120 cars and bikes on an area of 3'000 m2.


